

LEVY FACTS

- This levy request decreases our current levy level from \$1.65/\$1000 to \$1.64/\$1000 of property value which will be \$660,749.
- This is a three-year replacement levy and is not a new tax.
- For every dollar the levy raises; the state provides Granger approximately three dollars in levy equalization monies which will be \$1,725,118.
- We must pass our local levy, or we will lose all of the levy equalization monies from the state government.
